SPECIALTIES

The Specialty program provides divers with the opportunity to gain additional diving experience, update diving skills and become safer, more competent divers. Specialty divers develop the confidence and problem solving skills to plan, lead and more thoroughly enjoy their dives. The program is designed to be:

- FUN with hands on learning
- CONVENIENT

REQUIREMENTS

To become certified in a specialty, you must:

- Be at least 12 years old
- Be certified as a Open Water Diver, Junior Open Water Diver or equivalent

TRAINING PATH

The Specialty and Advanced program consists of taking SSI specialty courses: 2 for Specialty Diver with 12 logged dives and 4 for Advanced with logged 24 dives. Take SSI specialty courses and as you progress you will be recognized as you meet the Specialty Diver and Advanced Diver criteria listed above.



Log your dives on HPSC-sponsored trips for Specialty training once you return. Please check current travel schedule for more details.

COURSES

The HPSC Specialty program has a number of offerings that enable you to complete the program in a minimal amount of time. All courses are private and set up to work best with your schedule.
