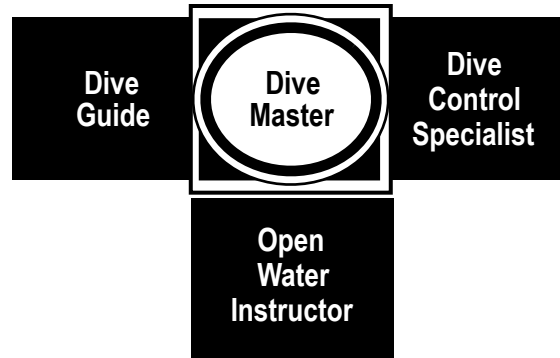

DIVE MASTER RATING

The SSI Dive Master rating allows the diver to assist in the instruction process and lead their fellow divers in underwater adventures. Successful completion of the Dive Master course denotes a high level of achievement and professionalism.

PREREQUISITES

Before applying to the candidates must:

- Be at least 18 years old.
- Have a current medical exam for diving signed by a physician.
- Have logged a total of at least 50 open water dives totaling 32 hours or more. Be certified an active Dive Guide level.
- Own your total diving system of professional quality.

REQUIREMENTS

- Have current certification in CPR, First Aid and oxygen provider.
- Complete the Science of Diving Course and have good working knowledge of the information.

TRAINING

The Dive Master Training program consists of approximately 12 hours of classroom: Encompassing: diving physics, physiology, decompression theory, aquatic environment, and components of the total diving system and final examination.

AFTER GRADUATION

After certification, an active Dive Master may:

- Conduct underwater tours to certified divers
- Teach snorkel diving and issue certification.
- Attend an SSI Dive Control Specialist Course

CAN NOT DO

Dive Master may **not**:

- Conduct or teach any SSI training programs for non-certified individuals or certified divers independently.
- Attend an Open Water Instructor training course.

ACTIVE STATUS

To maintain active status, a Dive Master must be affiliated with an SSI Dealer and have current insurance.

COST

Your fee of **\$175** includes:

- Academic instruction
 - SSI registration and documentation
- Fee does not include:
- Digital Science of Diving Course Materials (Standard \$50 or Diamond \$60)
