OPEN WATER DIVER

After finishing the Open Water Diver academic review and pool sessions, you're ready for certification as an Open Water Diver. You will demonstrate the skills you learned in the course during 4 open water dives.

You can complete your open water certification dives in the following ways:

- Join High Plains Scuba Center on one of our local dives in the summer or at The Crater in Utah all year long.
- Travel on an HPSC-sponsored trip to Cozumel, Bonaire, the Cayman Islands, or any other of our exotic destinations. Trips are available throughout the year.
- Arrange for a SSI Referral Form from HPSC to finish your dives on your next vacation.

You must complete your certification dives within 6 months of your last academic review and pool session.

REQUIREMENTS

In addition, you must:

- Provide your own mask, snorkel, boots, and fins. Ensuring your equipment fits well will make you more comfortable, provide better safety, and make your dives more fun. Gloves are also highly suggested for colder water dives.
- Feel comfortable and ready. Additional pool time may

be scheduled to increase your comfort level.

Before you proceed to your Open Water Certification you have an opportunity to spend more time in the water with one of our dive leaders. The purpose of the Referral Diver Practice session is to provide additional time in the water for your comfort and confidence under the supervision of a dive leader, but this is not a training session. This session usually occurs on the 3rd Saturday of the month from 3:00 pm - 4:00 pm and the cost is \$30.00.

Private Options:

- 1 - Student = \$60
- 2 - Students : \$55 each
- 3 - 6 Students: \$50 each

Please be sure to call ahead to schedule a time.

COURSE MATERIALS

Your class includes:

- Open water dives and instruction.
- Open Water Diver certification card.
- Equipment: BCD, regulator, tanks, weights, weight belt, and wetsuit as needed.
- Lodging* and fees at The Crater.
* Lodging based on double occupancy

Class does not include:

- Transportation.
 - Meals.
 - Mask, snorkel, boots, fins, hoods and gloves.
